Marryatt & MacKenzie owned and operated the store as a General Store - Grocer, Drapery and Hardware Store from 1921 right through to the Mid 1970's.

An antique Morris soft-top cruises around Cooroy today which was ordered and bought from the General Store in the 1930's. Imagine buying a new car from your corner store today? It even survived the Cooroy fires of 1937 which burnt up to the lower side of the building.
